Mobile Crisis

Mobile Crisis Response Team provided support to 318 individuals. A partnership with Waukesha County Department of Health and Human Services increased crisis response availability to 7 days per week.

Community Prevention

A comprehensive resource to educate individuals about mental wellness to reduce stigma associated with mental illness, so residents seek help sooner. Resources include Video Lending Library, Speaker's Bureau, Youth Peer Educators, Resource Center, Dial Harmony, and website. More than 34,000 pieces of literature were distributed to increase mental illness awareness, and 1,665 individuals received education about wellness.

211/First Call For Help

211/First Call For Help (211/FCFH) is a 'blended' helpline providing crisis intervention, emotional support, and referrals 24/7. Callers can also access confidential, anonymous Counseling Center Services and Outreach services through the helpline. Community Outreach Counselor provides services in the community, in-home, and at the MHA business office.

A 23% increase in client use: 48,363 helpline calls; 166 clients seen in Community Outreach; and 65 clients utilized Counseling Center.

Success Story

After viewing *David's Story*, a video on depression and suicide, a student expressed: "I learned that drugs and alcohol don't help. That depression can lead to suicide. I will watch for the warning signs in friends and try to help.

Dear Supporters,


MHA has completed another successful year. Clients' served increased 23% overall.
